

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF DECEMBER 2022

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for December was **\$255,000**, an increase of **6.3%** from December 2021.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose +7.6%, from \$263,000 a year ago to \$283,020.
- The median price in **East Baton Rouge Parish rose +5.8%**, from \$240,000 a year ago to **\$254,000**.
- The median price in Livingston Parish rose +6.0%, from \$230,000 a year ago to \$243,900.

MONTH'S SUPPLY OF HOUSING INVENTORY AS OF DECEMBER 2022



Greater Baton Rouge had **2.5 months supply** of inventory (+108.3% from 1.2 a year ago)



Ascension Parish had **1.8 months supply** of inventory (+157.1% from 0.7 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had **2.5 months supply** of inventory (+92.3% from 1.3 a year ago)



Livingston Parish had **2.2 months supply** of inventory (+83.3% from 1.2 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF NOVEMBER 2022

In November 2022, **225 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, a **decrease of 30%** compared to November 2021.

POPULATION

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is **roughly 850,000**. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

Livingston: 142,282
Assension: 136, 500

• Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for November 2022 is **3.3%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **2.6%**.

Construction employment in Louisiana gained **3,400 jobs** between November and December 2022, but lost **1,300 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **128,400** statewide.

Residential construction is at **6,900 jobs**, an increase of 100 jobs OTM, and specialty trade contractors gained **800 jobs** OTM and lost **1,700 jobs** OTY.
