

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF JANUARY 2023

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for January was **\$255,000**, an increase of **6.4%** from January 2022.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose +17.3%, from \$265,000 a year ago to \$310,815.
- The median price in **East Baton Rouge Parish rose +5.8%**, from \$243,450 a year ago to **\$262,658**.
- The median price in Livingston Parish rose +0.4%, from \$224,105 a year ago to \$225,000.

MONTH'S SUPPLY OF HOUSING INVENTORY AS OF JANUARY 2023



Greater Baton Rouge had **2.6 months supply** of inventory (+136.4% from 1.1 a year ago)



Ascension Parish had **2.1 months supply** of inventory (+250% from 0.6 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had **2.7 months supply** of inventory (+125% from 1.2 a year ago)



Livingston Parish had **2.2 months supply** of inventory (+83.3% from 1.2 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF DECEMBER 2022

In December 2022, **197 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, a **decrease of 34%** compared to **299** in December 2021.

POPULATION

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is **roughly 850,000**. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

• Livingston: **142,282**

• Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for December 2022 is **3.5%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **3.0%**.

Construction employment in Louisiana gained **3,300 jobs** between November and December 2022, but lost **1,000 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **132,500** statewide.

Residential construction is at **7,100 jobs**, an increase of 200 jobs OTM, and specialty trade contractors gained **2,100 jobs** OTM and lost **1,800 jobs** OTY.
