

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF FEBRUARY 2023

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for February was **\$254,308**, an increase of **0.1%** from February 2022.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose +12%, from \$281,210 a year ago to \$315,000.
- The median price in **East Baton Rouge Parish fell -1.7%**, from \$259,400 a year ago to **\$254,950**.
- The median price in Livingston Parish fell -0.4%, from \$242,883 a year ago to \$242,030.

MONTH'S SUPPLY OF HOUSING INVENTORY AS OF FEBRUARY 2023



Greater Baton Rouge had **2.7 months supply** of inventory (+145.5% from 1.1 a year ago)



Ascension Parish had **2.2 months supply** of inventory (+266.7% from 0.6 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had **2.8 months supply** of inventory (+133.3% from 1.2 a year ago)




Livingston Parish had **2.2 months supply** of inventory (+120% from 1.0 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF JANUARY 2023

In January 2023, **221 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, a **decrease of 32%** compared to **324** in January 2022.

POPULATION

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is **roughly 850,000**. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

• Livingston: **142,282**

• Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for January 2023 is **3.5%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **3.0%**.

Construction employment in Louisiana gained **500jobs** between December 2022 and January 2023, but lost **1,400 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **131,700** statewide.

Residential construction is at **6,800 jobs**, a decrease of **100 jobs** OTM, and specialty trade contractors lost **1,400 jobs** OTM and gained **700 jobs** OTY.
