

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF MARCH 2023

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for March was **\$259,900**, an increase of **3.1%** from March 2022.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose +5.2%, from \$285,000 a year ago to \$299,745.
- The median price in **East Baton Rouge Parish fell -0.6%**, from \$256,500 a year ago to **\$255,000**.
- The median price in Livingston Parish rose +4.4%, from \$239,535 a year ago to \$250,000.

Greater Baton Rouge had **2.6 months supply** of inventory (+136.4% from 1.1 a year ago)



Ascension Parish had **2.0 months supply** of inventory (+185.7% from 0.7 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had **2.7 months supply** of inventory (+145.5% from 1.1 a year ago)




Livingston Parish had **2.0 months supply** of inventory (+100% from 1.0 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF FEBRUARY 2023

In February 2023, **227 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, a **decrease of 18%** compared to **278** in February 2022.

Livingston: 142,282Ascension: 126,500

JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for February 2023 is **3.6%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **3.1%**.

Construction employment in Louisiana lost **600 jobs** between January 2023 and February 2023, but gained **5,000 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **136,700** statewide.

Residential construction is at **6,900 jobs**, an increase of **100 jobs** OTM, and specialty trade contractors lost **1,000 jobs** OTM and lost **800 jobs** OTY.
