

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF APRIL 2023

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for April was **\$260,000**, a **0%** change from April 2022.



- The median price in **Ascension Parish rose +4.1%**, from \$273,706 a year ago to **\$285,000**.
- The median price in East Baton Rouge Parish rose +1.9%, from \$264,888 a year ago to \$270,000.
- The median price in Livingston Parish fell -4.5%, from \$251,330 a year ago to \$240,000.



BUILDING PERMITS AS OF MARCH 2023

In March 2023, **263 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, a **decrease of 33%** compared to **392** in March 2022.

POPULATION

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is **roughly 850,000**. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

- East Baton Rouge: **456,781**
- Livingston: **142,282**
- Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for March 2023 is **3.6%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **2.9%.**

Construction employment in Louisiana gained **1,100 jobs** between February 2023 and March 2023, and gained **4,600 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **132,900** statewide.

Residential construction is at **6,900 jobs**, with no increase or decrease of jobs OTM, and specialty trade contractors gained **800 jobs** OTM and lost **200 jobs** OTY.
