

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF MAY 2023

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for May was **\$261,480**, a **3.6%** change from May 2022.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose +2.1%, from \$305,000 a year ago to \$311,500.
- The median price in **East Baton Rouge Parish rose +5.7%**, from \$257,250 a year ago to **\$272,000**.
- The median price in Livingston Parish fell -0.5%, from \$239,130 a year ago to \$238,000.

Ascension Parish had **2.6 months supply** of inventory (+136.4% from 1.1 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had **3.0 months supply** of inventory (+100% from 1.5 a year ago)




Livingston Parish had **2.4 months supply** of inventory (+71.4% from 1.4 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF APRIL 2023

In April 2023, **250 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, a **decrease of 25%** compared to **333** in April 2022.

POPULATION

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is **roughly 850,000**. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

• Livingston: 142,282

• Ascension: **126,500**



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for April 2023 is **3.6%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **2.8%**.

Construction employment in Louisiana gained **1,800 jobs** between March 2023 and April 2023, and gained **5,700 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **137,600** statewide.

Residential construction is at **7,100 jobs**, with an increase of **200 jobs OTM**, and specialty trade contractors gained **2,300 jobs** OTM and lost **2,000 jobs** OTY.
