

#### FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



## **MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF JUNE 2023**

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for June was **\$260,000**, a **0.8%** change from June 2022.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose 15.1%, from \$271,000 a year ago to \$312,000.
- The median price in East Baton Rouge Parish fell 1.7%, from \$270,000 a year ago to \$265,450.
- The median price in Livingston Parish fell 2.1%, from \$240,000 a year ago to \$235,000.

### **MONTH'S SUPPLY OF HOUSING INVENTORY AS OF JUNE 2023**



Greater Baton Rouge had 3.2 months supply of inventory (+68.4% from 1.9 a year ago)



Ascension Parish had 2.8 months supply of inventory (+86.7% from 1.5 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had 3.1 months supply of inventory (+55% from 2.0 a year ago)




Livingston Parish had 2.9 months supply of inventory (+93.3% from 1.5 a year ago)

#### **BUILDING PERMITS AS OF MAY 2023**

In May 2023, 320 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge were pulled, a decrease of **15.8%** compared to **380** in May 2022.

#### **POPULATION**

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is roughly 850,000. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

• Livingston: 142,282

• Ascension: 126,500



#### **IOBS**

The Louisiana unemployment rate for May 2023 is 3.6%; for Baton Rouge MSA it is 3.4%.

Construction employment in Louisiana gained 1,700 jobs between April 2023 and May 2023, and gained **7,700 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is 136,500 statewide.

Residential construction is at **7,200 jobs**, with an increase of 100 jobs OTM, and specialty trade contractors gained 900 jobs OTM and gained 3,000 jobs OTY.
