FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF AUGUST 2023

In Greater Baton Rouge, the median single-family home price for July was **\$255,000**, resulting in a **2.0%** change from August 2022.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose 2.6%, from \$294,500 a year ago to \$302,120.
- The median price in East Baton Rouge Parish rose 7.3%, from \$247,000 a year ago to \$264,950.
- The median price in Livingston Parish fell 0.5%, from \$231,145 a year ago to \$230,000.




MONTH'S SUPPLY OF HOUSING INVENTORY AS OF AUGUST 2023



BUILDING PERMITS AS OF JULY 2023

In July 2023, **276 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, a **decrease of 2.5%** compared to 283 in July 2022.

JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for June 2023 is **3.4%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **3.0%**.

Construction employment in Louisiana lost **1000 jobs** between May 2023 and June 2023, and gained **7000 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **136,800** statewide.

Residential construction is at **7,200 jobs**, with a decrease of **100 jobs OTM**, and specialty trade contractors lost **2,500 jobs** OTM and gained **1,100 jobs** OTY.
