

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF OCTOBER 2023

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for October was **\$259,900**, resulting in a **1.9% change** from October 2022.



- The median price in Ascension Parish fell 1.8%, from \$285,000 a year ago to \$280,000.
- The median price in East Baton Rouge Parish rose 0.9%, from \$259,900 a year ago to \$262,250.
- The median price in Livingston Parish rose 2.1%, from \$237,915 a year ago to \$243,000.

MONTH'S SUPPLY OF HOUSING INVENTORY AS OF OCTOBER 2023



Greater Baton Rouge had **3.8 months supply** of inventory (+46.2% from 2.6 a year ago)



Ascension Parish had **2.9 months supply** of inventory (+38.1% from 2.1 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had **3.9 months supply** of inventory (+44.4% from 2.7 a year ago)




Livingston Parish had **3.5 months supply** of inventory (+59.1% from 2.2 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF SEPTEMBER 2023

In September 2023, 270 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge were pulled, an increase of 6.7% compared to 253 in September 2022.

POPULATION

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

Livingston: 142,282Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for September 2023 is **3.3%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **3.1%**.

Construction employment in Louisiana gained **100 jobs** between August 2023 and September 2023, and gained **10,700 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **140,600** statewide.

Residential construction is at **7,400 jobs**, with a decrease of **100 jobs OTM**, and specialty trade contractors lost **100 jobs** OTM and gained **1,000 jobs** OTY.
