

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF NOVEMBER 2023

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for November was **\$260,588**, resulting in a **0.7% decrease** from November 2022.



- The median price in Ascension Parish fell 10.9%, from \$300,000 a year ago to \$267,250.
- The median price in **East Baton Rouge Parish rose 4.2%**, from \$260,000 a year ago to **\$271,000**.
- The median price in Livingston Parish fell 0.2%, from \$237,900 a year ago to \$237,465.

Greater Baton Rouge had 3.8 months supply of inventory (+40.7% from 2.7 a year ago)



Ascension Parish had 3.0 months supply of inventory (+42.9% from 2.1 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had 3.9 months supply of inventory (+44.4% from 2.7 a year ago)




Livingston Parish had 3.5 months supply of inventory (+52.2% from 2.3 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF OCTOBER 2023

In October 2023, 261 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge were pulled, an increase of **1.2%** compared to 258 in October 2022.

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is roughly 850,000. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

• Livingston: 142,282

• Ascension: 126,500



IOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for October 2023 is 3.3%; for Baton Rouge MSA it is 3.2%.

Construction employment in Louisiana lost 2,200 jobs between September 2023 and October 2023, and gained 12,900 jobs over the year. Total employment in construction is 138,000 statewide.

Residential construction is at 7,400 jobs, with a decrease of 100 jobs OTM, and specialty trade contractors lost 1,200 jobs OTM and gained 1,800 jobs OTY.
