


FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF JANUARY 2024

In Greater Baton Rouge, the median single-family home price for January was **\$258,000** resulting in a **1.2% increase** from January 2023.



- The median price in **Ascension Parish fell 10.3%**, from \$310,908 a year ago to **\$279,000**.
- The median price in East Baton Rouge Parish fell 0.5%, from \$262,658 a year ago to \$261,313.
- The median price in Livingston Parish rose 8.0%, from \$225,000 a year ago to \$242,938.

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF DECEMBER 2023

In December 2023, **217 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, a **decrease of 0.4%** compared to 197 in December 2022.

POPULATION

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is **roughly 850,000**. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

- East Baton Rouge: **456,781**
- Livingston: **142,282**
- Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for December 2023 is **3.7%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **3.3%**.

Construction employment in added **100 jobs** between November 2023 and December 2023, and gained **8,200 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **139,400** statewide.

Residential construction is at **7,600 jobs**, an increase **of 100 jobs OTM**, and specialty trade contractors gained **300 jobs** OTM and lost **400 jobs** OTY.
