


FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF FEBRUARY 2024

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for February was **\$257,000** resulting in a **0.9% increase** from February 2023.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose 1.6%, from \$315,000 a year ago to \$319,950.
- The median price in East Baton Rouge Parish rose 3.9%, from \$254,950 a year ago to \$265,000.
- The median price in Livingston Parish fell 2.8%, from \$243,900 a year ago to \$237,080.



BUILDING PERMITS AS OF JANUARY 2024

In January 2024, **270 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, an **increase of 59%** compared to 170 in January 2023.

POPULATION

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is **roughly 850,000**. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

- East Baton Rouge: 456,781
- Livingston: **142,282**
- Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for January 2024 is **4.1%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **3.8%**.

Construction employment in added **2400 jobs** between December 2023 and January 2024, and gained **1,300 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **134.900** statewide.

Residential construction is at **6,200 jobs**, an decrease **of 100 jobs OTM**, and specialty trade contractors gained **300 jobs** OTM and **700 jobs** OTY.
