

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF MAY 2024

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for May was **\$260,000** resulting in a **1.2% increase** from May 2023.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose 7.5%, from \$311,500 a year ago to \$335,000.
- The median price in East Baton Rouge Parish fell 2.7%, from \$272,250 a year ago to \$265,000.
- The median price in Livingston Parish rose 2.3%, from \$237,533 a year ago to \$242.933.

East Baton Rouge Parish had 3.9 months supply of inventory (+30% from 3.0 a year ago)




Livingston Parish had **3.9 months supply** of inventory (+62.5% from 2.4 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF APRIL 2024

In April 2024, 309 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge were pulled, an increase of **15%** compared to 269 in April 2023.

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is roughly 850,000. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

• Livingston: 142,282

• Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for April 2024 is 4.3%; for Baton Rouge MSA it is 3.0%.

Construction employment in added 1,300 jobs between March 2024 and April 2024, and gained 6,000 **jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **137,400** statewide.

Residential construction is at 6,300 jobs, no change in jobs OTM, and specialty trade contractors had increased 900 jobs OTM and are at 65,300.
