

FREDDIE MAC 30-YEAR FIXED MORTGAGE RATE



MEDIAN HOME PRICE AS OF JUNE 2024

In **Greater Baton Rouge**, the **median single-family home price** for June was **\$261,500** resulting in a **2.8% increase** from June 2023.



- The median price in Ascension Parish rose 10.8%, from \$309,850 a year ago to \$343,180.
- The median price in East Baton Rouge Parish rose 5.8%, from \$260,000 a year ago to \$275,000.
- The median price in Livingston Parish rose 2.4%, from \$234,000 a year ago to \$239,500.

Greater Baton Rouge had **4.6 months supply** of inventory (+35.3% from 3.4 a year ago)



Ascension Parish had **3.9 months supply** of inventory (+50% from 2.6 a year ago)



East Baton Rouge Parish had **4.0 months supply** of inventory (+29% from 3.1 a year ago)




Livingston Parish had **3.9 months supply** of inventory (+39.3% from 2.8 a year ago)

BUILDING PERMITS AS OF MAY 2024

In May 2024, **323 total single-family building permits in Greater Baton Rouge** were pulled, an **increase of 3.9%** compared to 311 in May 2023.

POPULATION

According to the most recent U.S. census, the Greater Baton Rouge population is **roughly 850,000**. Statistics on the most populated parishes are as follows:

• East Baton Rouge: 456,781

• Livingston: **142,282**

• Ascension: 126,500



JOBS

The Louisiana unemployment rate for May 2024 is **4.1%**; for Baton Rouge MSA it is **3.2%**.

Construction employment in added **100 jobs** between April 2024 and May 2024, and gained **700 jobs** over the year. Total employment in construction is **137,100** statewide.

Residential construction **lost 100 jobs OTM**, and specialty trade contractors have increased 1,000 jobs OTM and are at **65,000**.
